AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of November 24, 2004 (P.L.1270, No.153),
- entitled "An act providing for the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
- 3 System; authorizing and directing the Pennsylvania State
- Police to establish and maintain the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
- 5 System; assessing costs; and providing for immunity and
- penalties," further providing for duties of Pennsylvania
- 7 State Police.
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 9 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 1.1 of the act of November 24, 2004
- 11 (P.L.1270, No.153), referred to as the Pennsylvania Amber Alert
- 12 System Law, is amended to read:
- 13 Section 1.1. Duties of Pennsylvania State Police.
- 14 (a) Protocols and procedures. -- The Pennsylvania State Police
- 15 shall establish such protocols and procedures as are necessary
- 16 for the effective operation of each system and shall educate
- 17 and inform local law enforcement agencies and the public with
- 18 regard to the availability of each system.
- 19 (b) Particularly vulnerable children. -- This subsection shall
- 20 apply to particularly vulnerable children. If a parent or family

- 1 member reports that a child of the parent or family member has
- 2 been abducted by a nonparent or nonfamily member, there shall be
- 3 a presumption, absent immediately available clear evidence to
- 4 the contrary, that the child is in imminent danger of serious
- 5 bodily injury or death and the Missing Endangered Person
- 6 Advisory System shall be immediately activated without
- 7 additional investigation prior to activation of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Amber Alert System. This provision shall be known as the "Nalani
- 9 Johnson Rule" to protect this Commonwealth's particularly
- 10 <u>vulnerable</u> children from harm.
- 11 (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 12 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 13 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 14 <u>"Family member." A grandparent, aunt, uncle or adult sibling</u>
- 15 of a particularly vulnerable child.
- 16 <u>"Particularly vulnerable child."</u> A child under 13 years of
- 17 <u>age.</u>
- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
